



Neuseway Planetarium

Our 52 seat planetarium is a large round room with a 24 foot giant dome where the sky (sun, moon, stars, planets, etc.) is projected. Various planetarium shows are held daily and are subject to change periodically. Call for show times or to schedule a group tour. Our tours include planetarium shows that are designed to follow the state's curriculum guidelines for the 3rd, 6th, and 9th grades, but can also be custom designed to fit your groups' needs. Lenoir Memorial Hospital Health & Science Museum

This 5,000 square foot museum features hands-on health and science exhibits and programs. Exhibits include a "giant" Operation Game, a miniature replica of Lenoir Memorial Hospital that children can crawl into, an underground tunnel that portrays a human blood vessel, and a replica of the mouth, stomach, and intestines where you can crawl and explore. Exhibits change periodically.

Exchange Nature Center

Get your hands wet investigating a touch tank alive with crabs, sea urchins and starfish. Explore the numerous exhibits of plants and animals indigenous to North Carolina, including live poisonous and non-poisonous snakes, flying squirrels, talking birds, bears, bobcats and more. Venture into the cave in the lower level where you will find live turtle tanks, caiman, mineral exhibits, nocturnal animal displays and aquariums depicting life along the full course of the Neuse River.

Neuseway Nature Park, Campground & Meeting Facility

Located on 55 acres along the Neuse River, this beautiful nature-based park is brimming with fun things to do. Enjoy camping, hiking, fishing, biking, picnicing, canoeing and a 16 x 24 rock climbing wall.

Spend the night under the stars at this full hookup campground nestled along the Neuse River. The Kinston-Lenoir County Tourism Development Authority Campground has river accesses, hot showers, fire rings, picnic tables and a dump station. Fourteen sites with full hookups of 50-, 30- and 20-amp services are available for \$10 per night. Tent sites without hook-ups are available for \$6 a night. The campground is open 24 hours, 7 days a week.

Our newest addition to the camp site is a replica Indian tepee. This artistical canvas tepee can be rented for \$25 per night. Call (252) 939-3367 for more information.

The campground also features a meeting room equipped with a full kitchen and a picnic shelter that holds up to 60 people. These facilities can be rented on an hourly basis by calling the Parks and Recreation Department at (252) 939-3332.

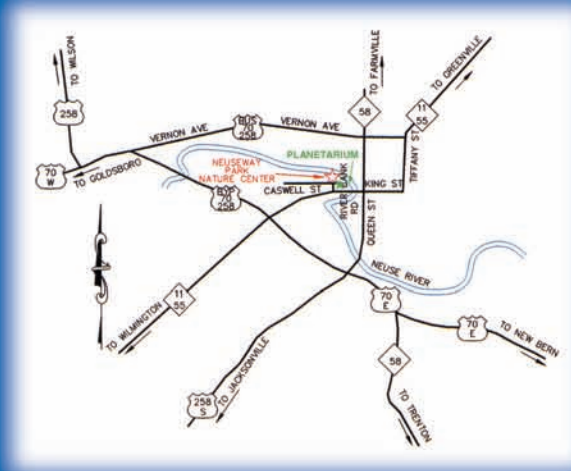
